

**MINUTES OF THE FOWLER CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
DECEMBER 7, 2004**

Mayor Simonian called the meeting to order in the Council Chambers at 6:05 p.m. Roll call was taken.

ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 1988

City Clerk Davis explained that Resolution No. 1988 was for declaring the official results of the November 2, 2004 municipal election. The official canvass of votes was attached as Exhibit A to the resolution.

Out of 1718 registered voters, there were 1,304 ballots cast. Total votes cast in the City of Fowler for three City Council positions were:
