5. **Public Hearing to Consider Zoning Text Amendment No. 09-01:** The Applicant proposes to amend Section 9-5.703(D) of the Zoning Ordinance to permit homing pigeons in the R-One Family Residential District and to amend the definition of household pets to specifically exempt homing pigeons from such definition.
6. **Public Hearing to Consider Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. 09-03:** Enviro Fuels Enterprises proposes to operate a biodiesel facility in the City of Fowler within an existing industrial building in the M-2 zone district located at 2398 S. Golden State Blvd. (3 ± acre portion of APNs 345-110-66 and 67). No changes are anticipated in the existing structure. Processing equipment for making biodiesel from vegetable oils will in installed in the existing building. The applicant's goal is to reach 200,000 gallons of biodiesel a month by the end of the first year; 500,000 gallons/month by Year 3, and 1,000,000 gallons/month by Year 5.
